What we are doing:



Monitoring our temperatures to be sure that we are healthy



Washing and sanitizing our hands, doors, front desk and exam rooms between each patient visit.



By limiting who we see in the office, we are able to get patients right into treatment rooms to avoid sitting in the waiting room.



We are offering telemedicine visits to our patients, and are available to speak to via phone, email and video.

What we are asking from our patients:

While the best thing to do to protect your health is to stay home, we do have patients that we must see to avoid hospitalization and adding to the burden on our local hospital systems. If you do need to come in, we remind you to:

Wash your hands and/or use hand sanitizer when you enter the office. Remember, gloves may protect your hands, but if you have been touching things with them, they may be contaminated and by touching our doors, chairs and surfaces with them, you could spread the virus.

Stay 3-6 ft apart from one another
